

U.S. Department of Interior Tackles FCC on Negative Impacts of Cell Towers on Wildlife



The RSC's conflicted review of Safety Code 6 is now released to the public. On April 1st, 2014, the Royal Society of Canada submitted its Review of Safety Code 6: Health Canada's Safety Limits for Exposure to Radiofrequency Fields. Despite selecting highly conflicted academics to its review panel, and having to replace three of them after a conflict of interest was exposed in the Canadian Medical Association Journal, the panel went ahead with its report.
